## Jogging Down Vowel Street Game Board Instructions

### **Game Instructions:**

#### (One Player)

- 1. Have student roll the die.
- 2. The number on the die is the number that the student can possibly move. As the student moves his/her player piece, have him/her read each word and write the word on the word sheet.
- 3. If the student reads or spells the word wrong, he/she must move back one space and his/her turn is over. If the student reads and spells each word correctly to fulfill his/her die roll then he/she stays on that space and his/her turn is over. If the student hits a road block, he/she must do the hand signals for all the vowels (a, i, o) and point to a picture on the game board that contains each vowel to continue to move forward.
- 4. The student wins when he/she reaches the finish.


#### **Game Instructions:**

#### (2 or more players)

- 1. Determine which student is to go first and have him/her roll the die.
- 2. The number on the die is the number that the student can possibly move. As the student moves his/her player piece, have him/her read each word and write the word on the word sheet.
- 3. If the student reads or spells the word wrong, he/she must move back one space and his/her turn is over. If the student reads and spells each word correctly to fulfill his/her die roll then he/she stays on that space and his/her turn is over. If the student hits a road block, he/she must do the hand signals for all the vowels (a, i, o) and point to a picture on the game board that contains each vowel to continue to move forward.
- 4. Have the next student roll the die and repeat steps 2 and 3.
- 5. The winner is the one who reaches the finish line first.
