Joking Around Game Board Instructions

Game Instructions:

(One player)

- 1. Shuffle the letter cards and place them face down in a pile.
- 2. Have the student pull a card and move their player piece to the nearest matching letter.
- 3. When the student moves his/her player piece to the matching letter on the game board, have him/her say the letter, the sound that it makes, and read the word below the letter. If the letter is a vowel, have him/her do the hand signal.
- 4. If the student gets any of the parts wrong, he/she moves back to START or the nearest joker and his/her turn is over. If the student gets everything right, he/she stays on the spot and his/her turn is over.
- 5 The student wins when he/she reaches the finish

Game Instructions:

(2 or more players)

- 1. Shuffle the letter cards and place them face down in a pile.
- 2. Determine the student who goes first and have them pull a card and move their player piece to the nearest matching letter.
- 3. When the student moves his/her player piece to the matching letter on the game board, have him/her say the letter, the sound that it makes, and the read the word below the letter. If the letter is a vowel, have him/her do the hand signal.
- 4. If the student gets any of the parts wrong, he/she moves back to START or the nearest joker and his/her turn is over. If the student gets everything right, he/she stays on the spot and his/her turn is over.
- 5. Have the next student pull a card and repeat steps 2-4.
- 6. The student who reaches the finish line first is the winner.
