5 Sound Tapping

Game Instructions:

(One Player)

- 1. You will need game boards, sheet protectors, and a dry erase/vis-a-vis marker.
- 2. Place the game boards in sheet protectors.
- 3. Using words from the word list, write a word onto the appropriate game board. Pay attention to digraphs, glued sounds, and blends. The combined three blocks are for glued sounds and the combined two blocks are for digraphs. Every single sound gets one block.
- 4. Once you write the word, have your student use his finger, a pencil, or any other tapping material to tap out each sound and then combine the sounds to make one word. If the word contains a digraph or glued sound, have your student point it out before tapping.
- 5. Repeat steps 3-4.
