SUPER CARD

Played like war. Evenly split the deck of word cards between the two players. The players stack their cards face down in front of them. At the same time, both players flip over the top card and lay it face up on the table. The card with the higher point value wins both cards. If there is a tie, both players flip over a second card as a tie breaker and the winner gets all four cards.

How do you determine the point value of a card?

Have players go through and circle where they see more than one consonant together.

Digraphs make one sound, so they are worth one point.

Blends make two sounds, so they are worth two points.

Digraph-blends (shr) make two sounds, so they are also worth two points.

Three letter blends make three sounds, so they are worth three points.

For example:

wi<u>sh</u> <u>clock</u> <u>splash</u> +1 +2 +1 +3 +1
